First Military Ordinance issued due to COVID-19

On 18 March 2020, in the context of the COVID19 pandemic, the Ministry of Internal Affairs issued Military Ordinance no. 1 supplementing the emergency measures instituting those regulated through the Presidential Decree.

During the state of emergency, the following activities are suspended: serving foods or beverages in common areas of restaurant, hotels, coffee-shops and other such public locations. Furthermore, cultural, artistical, scientific, sports, religious, entertainment, personal care etc. Also, all indoor gambling/betting activities shall be suspended for the same duration, as well as any other meetings or public gatherings of more than 100 individuals.

All commercial flights from and to Italy and Spain are suspended for the next period.
