

Lidl fined RON 272,000 for selling silver jewelry without authorization

The National Authority for Consumer Protection (ANPC) has sanctioned the retailer Lidl with fines totaling RON 272,000 for selling silver jewelry without authorization, informs the consumer protection watchdog.

ANPC has been in an extensive control campaign, for several days, at the level of the entire country, aimed at selling silver jewelry sets in Lidl stores.

The ANPC commissioners confiscated the goods and sanctioned and fined the economic operator, the contravention sanctions applied so far reaching 272,000 lei.

The verification action in this case is ongoing.
