

Romania's end electricity consumption in 2019 - similar to 2018 one

The country's end electricity consumption last year was 45,573 GWh, by only 7 GWh higher than the previous year, according to the National Institute of Statistics (INS).

Consumption in industry was 21,949 GWh, down 1.2%. In transport, the value of the indicator was by 0.4% higher, to 1,060 GWh, while public lighting increased by 10.7% to 578 GWh.

At the same time, the population's consumption was higher by 1.6%, reaching 12,984 GWh last year.

Consumption in the energy sector, including losses, was lower by 8.2%, to 11,100 GWh.

Last year, the country's net electricity production was 55,177 GWh, down 8.3%.
