

Ambassadors nominations: Emil Hurezeanu, to Austria, George Maior, to Jordan

Emil Hurezeanu and George Maior were officially nominated as Romania's ambassadors to Austria and Jordan.

Prior to this mission, Emil Hurezeanu was Romania's ambassador to Germany, and George Maior was ambassador to the United States of America.

"The Ministry of Foreign Affairs sent on Thursday towards the Foreign Policy committees and the Committees for the Romanian communities abroad within the Senate and the Chamber of Deputies, in conformity with the current regulations and relevant practices, the hearing request in the following period of 26 candidates for the position of extraordinary and plenipotentiary ambassador of Romania, following the approval of their being nominated by president Klaus Iohannis. For the 26 candidates the procedure has already been kicked off for applying for the approval of the accrediting state, according to the Vienna Convention on Diplomatic Relations, 1961," the Ministry of Foreign Affairs informs.
