

PM Citu: As of June 1, mask-free in spaces where there are no more than 5 vaccinated employees

Employees vaccinated against COVID will no longer be obligated, as of June 1, to wear a protection mask, if there are at most 5 people working in a closed space, the Government decided on Thursday.

According to PM Florin Citu, there were decisions made regarding foreign and stateless persons entering Romania, as tourists, as of June 1.

"Through the National Committee for Emergency Situations (CNSU), there were new exceptions introduced regarding the quarantine measure for people who are arriving in Romania from at risk areas, such as: people who have gone through the illness and are currently between the 14th and 90th day since being confirmed, children younger or equal to three years old, without having to present a negative RT-PCR test result for the infection with SARS-CoV-2 virus, children between 3 and 16, if they present the negative test of a RT-PCR tests for the SARS-CoV-2 infection, people who remain on the national territory for a period shorter than three days and present a negative SARS-CoV-2 test result," Citu specified.

The head of the Executive highlighted that through the newly adopted relaxation measures, we can see that the anti-COVID vaccination "helps and is worth it".

"We are quickly heading towards normalcy, the quicker we vaccinate, the quicker we can eliminate the other remaining restrictions," the PM said.
