

## Statistics: Wholesale trade turnover up by two figures in Jan-Nov 2021

**Wholesale trade turnover (except for the trade in motor vehicles and motorcycles) increased by almost 22pct January through November 2021, as gross series, and by 20pct as adjusted series, compared with the same interval in 2020, shows the data published on Tuesday by the National Institute of Statistics (INS).**

According to official statistics, in November 2021 vs November 2020, the wholesale trade businesses (without the data from the trade in cars and motorcycles) increased, as a gross series, by 26.8pct.

At the same time, the turnover in the same field of activity recorded a jump of 25.8pct, as series adjusted depending on the number of business days and seasonality, compared to the reference period.

From month to month (November vs. October 2021), wholesale trade activities (except for trade in motor vehicles and motorcycles) decreased by 4.3pct as gross series.

INS data also show a turnover in wholesale trade (except for the trade in motor vehicles and motorcycles), as a series adjusted depending on the number of business days and seasonality, decreasing overall by 0.4pct, in November 2021 compared to the previous month of the same year.
