Marian Enache: I wish for a bigger opening from CCR in relation with other public authorities

The President of the Constitutional Court (CCR), Marian Enache, said on Sunday, on the occasion of Justice Day, that he wants "a larger opening" from the institution in relation with other public authorities and representatives of all legal professions.

"During the first Sunday of July we are celebrating Justice Day. This day was established through Romania's Government Decision no. 364 on June 27, 1994, to mark the role and importance of judicial power, of partners, of all people in law enforcement, in trying to consolidate rule of law, also being a good opportunity for consolidating institutional relations. On this special moment, I wish good luck to all law professionals who contribute, through their specific activities, to a better administration of justice," Marian Enache declared.

He added that he wants a bigger opening from the Constitutional Court in relation with the other public authorities.

"With the purpose of increasing the quality of the constitutional act and for a better explanation of Court decisions, but also for our administrative constitutional court to better understand the concerns from the areas of other legal professions, I wish for a bigger opening from the Constitutional Court in relation with the other public authorities and with the representatives of all legal professions. Justice aims for the rights and fundamental liberties of people, as well as their legitimate interests, which need to be guaranteed through a fair justice. Just as a large thinker expressed himself, the judge must always 'politely listen', to answer wisely, to cautiously weight and to impartially decide," the CCR chairman also said.
