

ELCEN becomes member of HENRO - the Electricity Producers Association

HENRO - the Electricity Producers Association is expanding its membership just one year after its establishment through the joining of Electrocentrale Bucuresti SA (ELCEN), informs a press release sent to AGERPRES on Wednesday.

According to the cited source, ELCEN is the largest thermal energy producer in Romania (40%) and Bucharest (90%). In terms of electricity production, ELCEN provides 3.88% of the national market share.

The members of HENRO - SPEEH Hidroelectrica SA, Electrocentrale Bucuresti SA (ELCEN), SN Nuclearelectrica SA, SNGN Romgaz SA and SC Complexul Energetic Oltenia SA - total over 11,700 MW of installed power and provide over 70% of the electricity used nationally.

Thus, the Electricity Producers Association succeeds in uniting the largest Romanian energy producers under the auspices of the acronym HENRO aiming to represent electricity producers in dialogue with authorities and stakeholders, to express and support common positions on electricity issues and to promote market development by encouraging the principles of a liberalized market, such as fair competition, transparency, non-discriminatory access and best practices for the benefit of the end customer.

HENRO represents electricity producers that exploit production capacities of over 11,700 MW ensuring over 70% of Romania's annual electricity consumption, with prospects of completing new production capacities.
