

Group of companies to invest EUR 15 million in Romania's circular economy

Fepra Waste Division (FWD), a group of companies established to support companies in the sustainability process, will invest 15 million euros throughout 2030 to develop the circular economy in Romania based on a complex sustainable development strategy developed in partnership with the European Bank for Reconstruction and Development (EBRD).

FEPPRA is thus strengthening its role as a catalyst of the circular economy in Romania and intends to invest EUR 15 million throughout 2030 in order to secure a reduction in the impact on the environment for a more sustainable future.

Therefore, FEPPRA aims to increase the recycling volume of plastic packaging waste by over 20,000 tonnes per year and to establish a national network of partners, as well as 50 mixed waste collection centres of a capacity of collection of over 450 tonnes of plastic monthly, thus offsetting the emission of approximately 360 tonnes of CO₂ per month.

Over the past two years, the company went through an extensive strategic planning process, starting from an analysis of the current market landscape and the legislative framework, as well as global trends that will shape the future.
